80 weeks of clinical rotations

- 42 weeks of cores: Medicine (12), Surgery (12), Pediatrics (6), Ob-Gyn (6), Psychiatry (6)
 - Corresponding USMLE questions for each core rotation
 - Peds: 300 total
 - Medicine: 400 total
 - Ob-Gyn: 205 total
 - Psych: 150 total
 - Surgery: 162 total
- 16 weeks of required electives, 4 weeks each
 - Medicine Sub-I
 - Medicine elective
 - Pediatric Sub-I OR elective
 - Family Medicine (may be 4-6 weeks)
- 22 weeks of general electives, 4 weeks each (note: students with a 6-week Family Medicine rotation will have 20 weeks of general electives)
 - Elective 1-5
 - Elective 6 (only for those who need it, 2 weeks)
